Mavericks Missoula Athletic Council Scholarship Form

In December 2015, MFSC received a grant from the Mavericks Missoula Athletic Council. The purpose of this grant is to provide scholarships for our Skating School program. The Skating School is our bridge program which brings skaters from our "Learn to Skate" program and introduces them to the club skating environment through group lessons during the more advanced Skating School program. Our Skating School takes place on Sunday afternoons from 4:00 to – 5:00 pm and features group instruction on edges, power, control, moves in the field, dance, spins, jumps, pairs, synchronized skating and tricks. We also incorporate a performance element for each session of Skating School.

MFSC is offering <u>up to \$50</u> in a Skating School scholarship <u>per skater per skating season</u> (Sept-Jun). Actual amount per skater will be determined by the MFSC Board based on available funds.

Preference will be given to skaters who are participating, coaching or assisting in the Learn to Skate program.

Requirements for Scholarship are as follows:

- Skater must be a member of Missoula Figure Skating Club: First Time Member \$30, Subsequent Year Member \$60, Second Family Member \$30
- Skater must have passed Basic Skills Level 3
- Must complete Scholarship Form
- Scholarship Form is due by Sept 11th for Fall Session or by Jan 1st for Winter Session of 2016-17 season.
